

Getting started with e-books – a step-by-step guide

To access our downloadable e-books you will need:

- An internet connected computer, laptop, ipad/tablet, or iphone/smartphone with internet access enabled. Remember the basic level Amazon Kindle eBook reader is not compatible with our eBook lending system but a Kindle Fire is.
- A valid library membership number.
- A valid library pin number or password.
- PC and MAC desktop users will need Adobe Digital Editions. This is available via the Adobe website.
- All other Apple users will need the Adobe Bluefire App. Android users will require the Aldiko App. Both are available free via the Apple Apps store and the Android Marketplace.

How does it work?

Step 1 – Browse

You can go directly to our e-books website and search for books there (URL). You can do that by clicking here. You will be asked for your library membership number and password before you can complete a search.

You can look for e-books by searching the LibrariesNL online library database (URL). Simply search for books as normal and the system will tell you if we have an e-book version available.

Step 2 – Check Out

Once you have selected an e-book you wish to borrow simply click on 'add to basket' and the item will be ready when you wish to download it. Note: if a title is not available you may put a reserve on it. You will then receive an email when the title is available for checkout.

Once you have selected all the e-books you wish to borrow (you are able to borrow or reserve up to 6 at any one time), click on 'proceed to checkout'.

Step 3 – Download and enjoy!

Once you have clicked on 'proceed to checkout', your title will be processed. Once processed, you are ready to download your e-books. Click on the download button under each title and the e-book will be downloaded to your device. Remember if you do not already have Adobe Digital Editions installed on your PC or MAC desktop, or a recognised e-reader app, the system will prompt you to download and activate this software before you can download your e-books.

E-books are loaned for up to 28 days. Items will automatically delete once this loan period has expired.
