Technology for Communicating

Sunday 1, 8 and 15 September 1.30pm - 4.30pm 16+vrs / £25 for 3 sessions or £10 each

Three workshops designed for you to get the most out of technology for making films, animations or podcasting either as an online communication tool or using these mediums in their own right.

Bring your own device along, or use ours.

Workshop 1 How to use video on social media to best effect, covering lighting, camera, formats and pros and cons of various editing software available.

Workshop 2 Sound tracks and how to create simple soundtracks for film. Exploring Foley effects and 'real worlding' of effects for use.

Workshop 3 How best to record for filming, broadcasting and podcasting. Learn about microphone setup and how to record on portable devices and straight to software.



Animation Days – based on Lego Movie 2 Monday 14 or Tuesday 15 October / 11am - 3pm / 8-13yrs / £10

This is a one day workshop led by an animation artist, where you will explore the world of Lucy, Emmet and Batman, and make your own contribution to the story so far for the citizens of Bricksburg.

Using Lego, you can create your own backdrops and sets, add characters, then bring your story to life through the animation process, including sound and music. Your finished work will be posted on VIMEO for you to view and download at home.

Curriculum for Excellence cross-curricular experiences and outcomes include Art and Design, Science Materials and Social Studies/ Technology.


Secondary Schools
