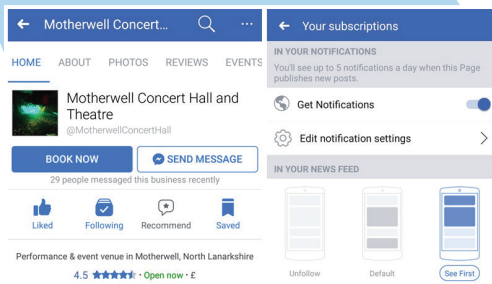

Twin Atlantic are a 4-piece alternative rock band from Glasgow who released their Top 10 , critically acclaimed album 'GLA' in 2016.

Their performance on Later With Jools Holland, and their nomination as one of the UK's best live acts two years running, comes after doing three sold out shows at Glasgow's Barrowland Ballroom, a headlining show at SSE Hydro Arena, and many sold out UK tours over the past eight years and across three albums and an EP.

Their 2015 album 'Great Divide' was also a Top 10 album (#6).

'GLA' was written in Glasgow, and the band set off to Topanga Canyon in Los Angeles to record the album, working with Jacknife Lee (U2, Snow Patrol, Two Door Cinema Club) who had previously produced some tracks for previous Top 10 album 'Great Divide' (2014). Under his direction, they avoided old school recording techniques, taping their parts separately. This change in their recording process marked the grander ambitions of the new songs, while their dream mixer Alan Moulder (Arctic Monkeys, Foals, Foo Fighters and My Bloody Valentine) came aboard to give the album the essential finishing touch.



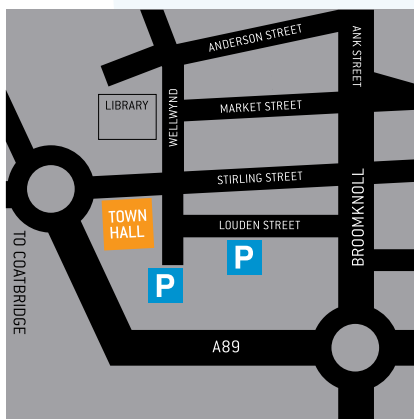

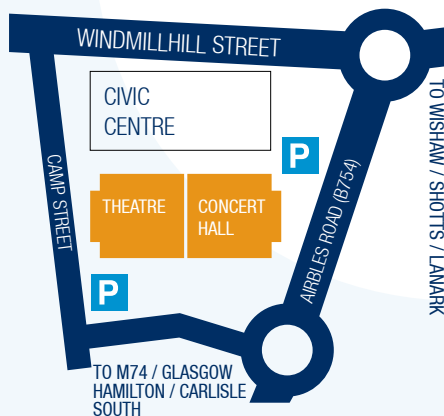
