


Snackable Smores Sheep

Ingredients

Per sheep you will need the following:

- 1 large marshmallow
- 10 small marshmallows
- 1 small pretzel
- White icing to attach pretzel feet and small marshmallows to large marshmallow
- Food safe pen



Step 1: Use food-safe pen and draw sheep face onto large marshmallow.



Step 2: Cut mini marshmallows in half. Take one half marshmallow and cut in half again and then colour each half with red or pink food safe pen to represent sheep ears.



Step 3: Use water icing or icing pen to attach mini marshmallows all over large marshmallow. Don't forget to put ears on the sheep.



Step 4: Place a small amount of icing onto pretzel and place sheep on top.



Step 5: Congratulations, good job, sheep complete.



Step 6: Repeat steps as often as required to achieve a flock of sheep.
