

INSIDE/OUTSIDE YOUR HOUSE

Part 1 is an observational drawing exercise. Look around the room you're in and draw it!

You will need:

- Paper
- Drawing materials
- Potato and knife (AN ADULTS HELP IS NEEDED FOR THIS PART)
- Paint

Part 2 will show you how to make a variation of potato stamps that you can use to make a print of the outside of your house by following these steps:

- Think about what shapes your house is made up of.
- Ask an adult to help you cut out a square, a triangle and parallelogram from your potato. See video for additional 'decorative' shape suggestions eg doors/windows
- Paint onto your stamps
- Press stamp firmly onto page and build up your image
- Allow to dry before adding details such as doors and windows.
