


You will need:

- -Box
- -Ruler
- -Pen
- -Tracing paper
- -Scissors
- -Glue stick
- -materials eg: flowers + leaves
- Measure and clearly mark a 2cm border on each face of your box.
- Using scissors, carefully cut out the faces of your box leaving your border intact as a frame.
- Measure the tracing paper to fit into each face of your box (incl border).
 Measure this from the edges of your frame so that excess tracing paper can be used to glue your panel in place.
- Once you have your tracing paper panels, mark the area that you will see through the face so you know what area to work on. The border area should match that of your box and this is the area you will glue later.
- Use a glue stick to stick down your leaves and petals etc. You might want to make a pattern, create a landscape scene or just collage!
- Once your panels are finished and dry, glue along your tracing paper border and place your panels into your box. Press firmly along the edges to secure in place.
- Hold up to the light for full effect!
