

Lesson 6 - Jungle Painting

Description

In this class we will be making a colourful jungle painting. A template is supplied below if you would like to print and trace.

You Will Need:

- Acrylic or gouache paints in a range of colours
- A4 paper or larger if you prefer
- Light pencil (2H recommended)
- Masking tape
- Coloured pencils
- Water
- Paintbrushes in various sizes
- Paint pallet or tray

Steps :

1. Trace template below or draw an outline of your own image
2. Use masking tape to mask off the edges of the image - I painted this at A5 but you could go bigger or smaller if you wanted to.
3. In the example, I painted with hot pink, dark purple, warm blue, forrest green, light blue and bright orange, using your colours, begin to select areas to insert colour.
4. As there are no outlines here, it is important to paint different colours next to each other to help them to stand out - a plan is provided below if you would like to follow it.
5. Once you have painted all of the shapes, leave to dry
6. Once dry, use coloured pencils to add fun patterns to the shapes (e.g. dots, stripes, wiggly lines). Use contrasting colours such as red pencil on orange paint to help it to stand out
7. Use a lighter colour to add texture to the toucan
8. Gently remove your masking tape to reveal a clean edge to your artwork
9. Trim artwork to desired size and frame
