They offer many services to their communities – groups and activities, and a safe space to spend time around others, even if you head in on your own. Leisure venues can play a significant role in combating isolation, linking users to their wider community and helping them to take more control over their health and wellbeing.

By joining us as a Communitea Connector Volunteer, you can help us link people to each other and to activities in their local communities.

What's involved

You'll help to run Communitea, a new volunteer-led service provided by NL Leisure designed to support the local population to feel included in their community by offering a shared space for a cup of tea and a blether. The service will complement existing services provided by leisure.

Activities include:

- Setting out and tidying up the Communitea space
- Meeting and greeting people, providing a warm welcome
- Facilitating and encouraging conversation
- Providing a friendly, listening ear
- Explaining the resources and services available across Active & Creative Communities
- Highlighting events and classes & encouraging attendance
- Supporting people on a one to one basis, depending on their individual needs
- Signposting people to relevant local services
- Maintaining signposting literature as required
