#### About the Role

We are looking for volunteers to gently lead informal group grief sessions in a friendly and non-judgemental manner, supporting participants in the groups to ensure they feel included and supported.

Bellshill Cultural Centre, John Street, Bellshill. Time: Thursdays, 6pm - 7pm.

#### What's involved?

Activities you could be involved in include:

- Helping to set up and close down
- Meeting and greeting participants, providing a warm welcome
- Encouraging the participants to share their thoughts openly in the group
- Engaging with group participants around their grief as appropriate
- Signposting participants to other services when necessary
- Reassuring the group that certain thoughts and actions are normal
- Ensuring basic paperwork is completed/collected for each session
- Promoting Libraries wider services where appropriate

- Induction, initial and ongoing training to support your development
